## Tax File Number Notification Information

RBF is required to request your Tax File Number (TFN) under the *Superannuation Industry (Supervision) Act 1993*.

Your TFN will only be used for lawful purposes, including recording your concessional and non-concessional contributions, calculating tax payable on your benefits, and providing information to the Commissioner of Taxation. If you transfer your benefit to another super provider, RBF may disclose your TFN to that provider unless you request otherwise in writing. These purposes may change in the future.

**Giving us your TFN is voluntary and it is not an offence if you choose not to do so.**

### Advantages of providing your TFN:

- RBF will be able to accept all types of contributions to your account
- Tax on your concessional contributions will not increase
- No additional tax will be deducted when you start drawing down your benefit
- It will be much easier to keep track of your super to ensure you receive all your benefits when you retire.

These consequences may change in the future, depending on superannuation legislation.
